IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- You must provide your own tent, table(s) and booth set-up.
- You must come prepared to make changes for your customers, as we are not able to offer a change-making service.
- This is a rain or shine market, so please come prepared for wet weather. Should the weather turn dangerous, we will cancel or postpone the market.
- It is very important that you have weights with you EVERY WEEK to keep your tent from blowing away. They can be the fancy weights that you buy in stores, or they can be milk jugs filled with water, but you will find that we need them most of the time, even in sunshine
- Restrooms will be on site
- Sellers must have a sign clearly showing their name.
- All products for sale should be priced clearly and displayed in a manner that does not confuse or mislead the customer.
- All products offered for sale must be of good quality and condition. The market manager reserves the right to direct that inferior goods be removed from display.
- Each seller is responsible for all equipment and supplies for the setup of their booth.
- Sellers are required to keep their market space neat, visually pleasing, and clear of litter and debris.
- Bona fide producers of New York State agricultural products may sell in the market. Agricultural products include, but are not limited to fruits, vegetables, cider and fruit juices, eggs, honey and honey products, maple products, cheese and dairy products, meat and poultry, NYS wines, bedding plants, nursery products and cut flowers. Locally made baked goods and edibles are also welcome. 80% of the product offered has to be items the vendor has produced or grown, with no more than 20% having been purchased or acquired for resale. Those products purchased for resale must still be New York State produced. Craft vendors, with products made by the seller, may be sold at the market. Imports or distribution products are not allowed. Acceptance of each craft vendor is left to the discretion of the market manager based upon the nature of the products and those already at the market. Being a local community market, we tend to see the same visitors week after week. Where produce vendors, bakers, and others selling consumable goods tend to see a strong weekly following, craft vendors may experience a surge at the start of the market and a gradual decline as the year progresses. General Liability Insurance: Vendors are strongly encouraged to carry general liability insurance to protect them in the event of any legal action brought by a third party in connection with unforeseen activities or accidents.
